

Curriculum Coverage for Spring Term in Year 5/6

We have lots of exciting learning planned for Spring Term 2024.

SCIENCE

EVOLUTION AND INHERITANCE

- To recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- To identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways.
- To understand that adaptation of plants and animals to suit their environment may lead to evolution.
- Evolution and Inheritance: Darwin
- To recognise that living things have changed over time and that a number of factors can affect a species' evolution.
- To understand how human have evolved over time, and how human behaviour can affect change in species over time.

HISTORY - VIKINGS Vs ANGLO SAXONS

- To explore what Britain was like before the first Viking invasions.
- To find out about the Viking invasions of Britain.
- To find out about the Viking settlement of Britain and how this affected the Anglo-Saxons.
- To find out why King Alfred was dubbed 'Alfred the Great'.
- To explore what life was like for Vikings living in Britain.
- To find out how and when England became a unified country.
- To find out about the end of the Anglo-Saxon and Viking era in Britain.

GEOGRAPHY - OUR LOCAL AREA

- To be able to suggest questions for enquiry.
- To be able to suggest a map for a particular purpose.
- To be able to measure straight line distance on a plan.
- To be able to recognise OS map symbols.
- To be able to follow a short route on an OS map and describe features found (Y6)
- To be able to collect and record evidence unaided
- To use primary sources of evidence in their investigations
- To be able to draw a map based on their data
- To be able to draw maps of increasing complexity
- To be able to draw a plan view map with some accuracy
- To analyse evidence and draw conclusions.
