Curriculum Coverage for Summer Term in Key Stage 1

We have lots of exciting learning planned for Summer Term 2024.

This term in Geography our topic is

Let's Go On Safari

The children will locate Africa on a map and identify the country of Kenya, we will explore the climate and animals of Kenya.

We will learn how to use a compass and navigate around a map. We will explore the landscapes of Africa and find out about the people and culture of Kenya. We will compare the difference between Kenya and the UK.

In PSHCE we will be focusing on

Me and My Body

The children will be learning about how our bodies grow and develop as we get older. We will discuss staying safe and appropriate touch.

My Money

During this topic we will be learning about money, how we use it and how we can invest and save our money for the future and create sensible spending habits.

In science, our topic is

My Body

During this topic children will identify, name and label parts of the body and explore what parts of our bodies we use for different activities. We will explore the five senses.

Super Scientists

This topic gives children an opportunity to become 'super scientists.' We will plan, conduct and evaluate a variety of experiments.

In DT we will be designing and making Pouches

The children will design and make a pouch. They will use running stich and their imagination to add detail.

In art we will be exploring **Tessellation**

As part of this art topic the children will explore a variety of shapes and will create tessellation patterns (which shapes can be used to create a tessellation picture? Lets find out!)

In Music, we will be listening to a variety of music genres as well as identifying **pulse**, **rhythms** and **pitch** in different music.

In ICT we will be looking at moving a Robot and Robot Algorithms.
