Curriculum Coverage for Summer Term in Year 5/6

We have lots of exciting learning planned for Summer Term 2024.

SCIENCE

Healthy Bodies

- To investigate some different food groups and find out why a variety of foods is important for a healthy diet.
- To find out how nutrients and water are transported in the human body
- identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood
- To investigate what happens to the heart when we exercise and why.
- To investigate how muscles move the skeleton and how muscle activity requires increased blood flow.
- To investigate the effects of tobacco, alcohol and other drugs.
- Describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

Life Cycles

- To describe the process of sexual reproduction in flowering plants.
- To describe the process of asexual reproduction in plants.
- To describe the process of sexual reproduction in animals.
- To observe and compare the life cycles of animals in our local environment with other animals around the world.
- To compare how different animals reproduce and grow.
- To find out about the work of naturalists.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In Spring Term, we will be learning all about: ISLAM

HISTORY - VIKINGS Vs ANGLO SAXONS

To explore what Britain was like before the first Viking invasions.

To find out about the Viking invasions of Britain.

To find out about the Viking settlement of Britain and how this affected the Anglo-Saxons.

To find out why King Alfred was dubbed 'Alfred the Great'.

To explore what life was like for Vikings living in Britain.

To find out how and when England became a unified country.

To find out about the end of the Anglo-Saxon and Viking era in Britain.

GEOGRAPHY - OUR LOCAL AREA
