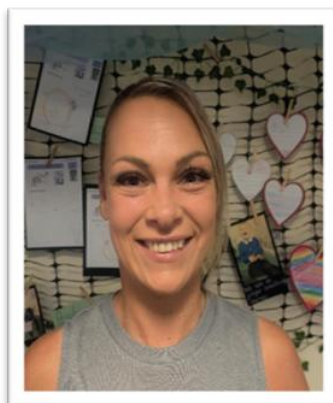

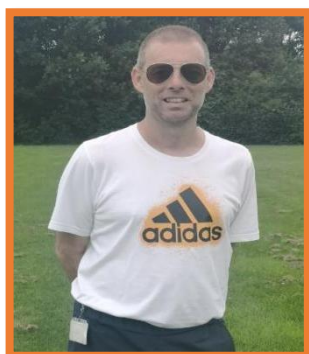

Curriculum Coverage for Spring Term in Key Stage 1

We have lots of exciting learning planned for Spring Term 2026.

This term in Geography our topic is

Around The World

The children will be looking at maps and globes and identifying a variety of countries and looking at their features and characteristics. We will explore the climate in a variety of places and what it is like for the people that live there.

Our history topic is **Toys Past and Present**. We will be looking at a variety of toys that we use and play with today and how they compare to toys from the past.



In science, our topic is **Living Things and Their Habitats**.

As part of this topic we will be looking at a variety of animals and their habitats. We will look at how animals have adapted and are suited to their habitats as well as looking at food chains in a variety of environments.



In One-Life we will be focusing on **Bouncing Back**. We will be thinking how to stay positive and be resilient when things don't go our way as well as how to support ourselves and our friends who may find this difficult.

We will also be considering how important **Healthy Choices** are and considering how we can stay healthy and look after our bodies.



In art we will be exploring **Clay** looking at a variety of ways to mould, sculpt and be creative with clay.

We will then design and create our own clay tile that includes an animal in its habitat (after learning about them through our science topic).

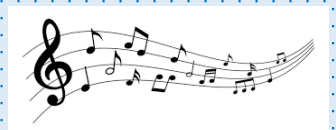
In **DT** we will be creating 'moving monsters' with moving mechanisms and pivots.

Our PE topics will be **Dance** followed by **football**

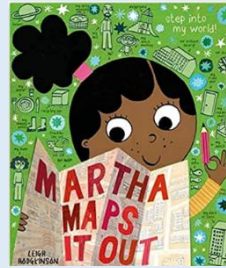
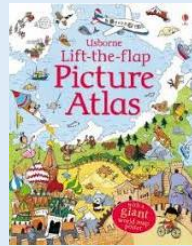
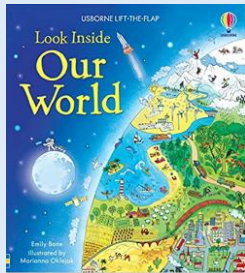
In Music, we will be listening to a variety of music genres as well as identifying **pulse**, **rhythms** and **pitch** in different music.

In RE we will be studying the religion of **Christianity**.

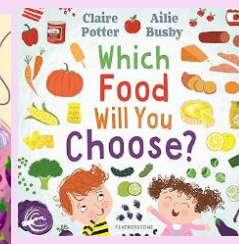
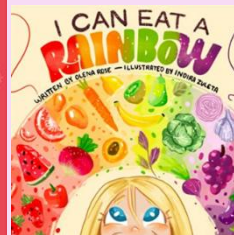
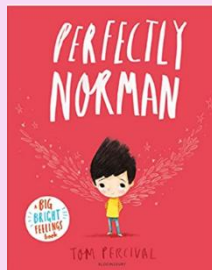
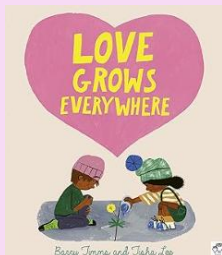
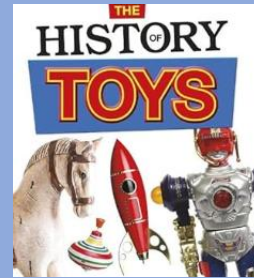
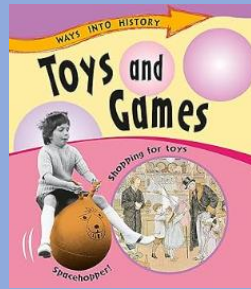
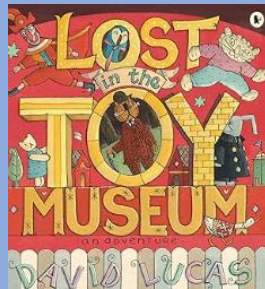
