The purpose of this letter is to provide some information and reminders which we hope will support us all as we continue to work together.

## Key Reminders

### Lost Property

- Please name all clothing and belongings. We already have a number of lost property items with no name on.
- This helps us return items quickly to their rightful owner.

### Mobile Phones

- Phones should not be brought to school unless needed for walking home alone.
- Must be handed to the class teacher each morning.
- Parents/carers must complete a form (available from the office).
- School cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage.

### Uniform & Jewellery

- No make-up, false nails or false eyelashes. The wearing of nail polish is also not permitted.
- Earrings should be small studs only.
- Earrings must be removed on PE days (taken out before school if the child cannot do this themselves).

### School Site Expectations

- Smoking and vaping are not permitted anywhere on site.
- Dogs are not allowed on site (including dogs that are carried).
- These rules are in place for the safety and wellbeing of all.

### School Meals

- Dinner accounts must always be kept in credit.
- Our catering provider cannot provide meals without sufficient funds.

- All children in F2 and KS1 continue to receive free meals under the Government's Infant Free School Meal policy.
