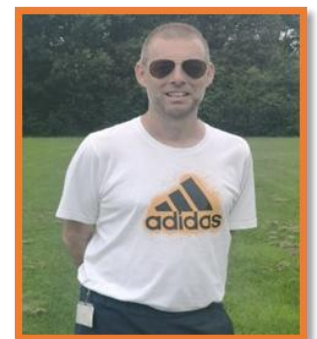

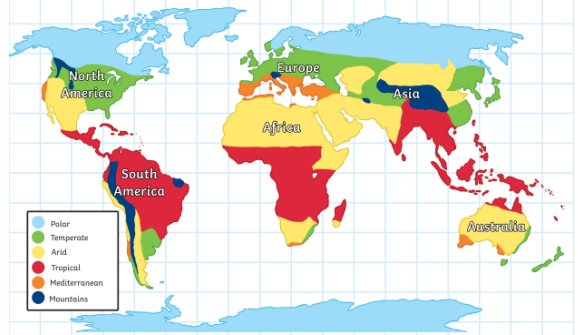

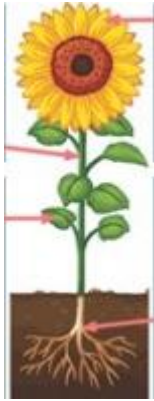

Curriculum Coverage for Spring Term in Classes 4 and 5

In Geography, we will be learning about countries in Europe. We will also learn about where our food comes from and explore different climate zones and biomes.



In science, we will learn about plants and will explore what they need for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow). We will look at the life cycle of flowering plants and learn different ways of sorting living things using branching diagrams.



In DT we will learn so much in our food technology unit:

- ✓ Evaluating and comparing a range of products.
- ✓ Identifying a target audience.
- ✓ Adapting a recipe.
- ✓ Following a baking recipe.
- ✓ Designing a biscuit within a given budget.
- ✓ Conducting market research.
- ✓ Understanding safety and hygiene rules.
- ✓ Suggesting modifications.
- ✓ Evaluating an adapted recipe.

In PSHCE, we will learn about resilience and compassion.

Our RE focus this term is Christianity and we will explore special places, times and words in the Christian Faith.



We will be creative with colour in art and learn about Seurat – a famous artist who used pointillism and create some of our own fabulous pointillist artworks.

In PE, we will enjoy dance and tag rugby. Our computing topics are desktop publishing and data and information. In Spanish, we will be learning the names for animals and fruits and vegetables. In music, we will continue with our Charanga scheme of learning and look at composing music together and expressing feelings with music.
