All homework needs to be returned every Thursday. If any homework is not completed by Friday, the school expectation is that your child will stay in during Friday break time to complete what they haven't done.

If your child completes all of their homework on time, they will receive a raffle ticket. These raffle tickets build up over the half term and then 5 tickets are drawn at random and given prizes. The more your child does this, the greater chance they will have of winning a prize!
