Curriculum Coverage for Spring Term in Years 3 and 4

In Geography, we will be learning about where our food comes from and exploring different climate zones around the world.



In science, we will learn about plants and will explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from soil, and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant and we'll look at the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.



In DT we will learn so much in our food technology unit:

- Evaluating and comparing a range of products.
- Identifying a target audience.
- Adapting a recipe.

- Following a baking recipe.
- Designing a biscuit within a given budget.
- Conducting market research.

- Understanding safety and hygiene rules.
- Suggesting modifications.
- Evaluating an adapted recipe.

In PSHCE, we will learn about forming and managing healthy relationships with others and making healthy choices as we grow up.

Our RE focus this term is Christianity and we will explore special places, times and words in the Christian Faith.





We will be creative with colour in art and learn about Seurat - a famous artist who used pointillism and create some of our own fabulous pointillist artworks. We will look at Andy Warhol and create some of our own pop art too.
