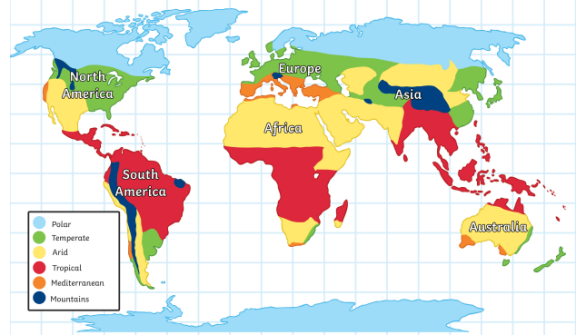

Curriculum Coverage for Summer Term in Classes 4 and 5

In Geography, we will learn about where our food comes from and explore different climate zones and biomes (moved forward from Spring Term) and enjoy fieldwork activities in our school grounds.



In science, we will learn about food chains, teeth and digestion. We will also learn about how objects vibrate to create sounds and how sound waves travel to our ears. We will investigate how to alter the pitch of sounds and how the distance away from sounds affects the volume.



In DT, we will make our own pneumatic pop up toy. In art, we will be finding out about the famous artist Picasso and creating some of our own portraits using pencil. We will explore the use of colour and make an abstract portrait too.



Our History topic is the Ancient Mayans and we will learn about when and where they lived, some fascinating facts about their way of life some of their beliefs and rituals.



In PSHCE, we will learn about respectful relationships face to face and online and about self-esteem. We will learn about ways to prevent illness and disease and learn about hazards and practical ways to stay safe. We'll also learn about our growing and changing bodies and keeping ourselves clean and safe.

Our RE focus this term is Islam.

In PE, we will enjoy playing basketball and taking part in lots of fun athletic lessons.

Our computing topic is programming where we will use Scratch program to sequence sounds and create repeating shape patterns.
