Dear Parents

We are pleased to inform you we are organising a residential visit for five days and four nights for children in Years 5 and 6 to The Ullswater Outward Bound Activity Centre in the Lake District. This is a centre that we have visited before and gives the children the chance to have lots of a new experiences, although it is linked to the Howtown centre that we have visited for a number of years. Further information can be found at - <https://www.outwardbound.org.uk/centres/ullswater/> The previous visits have been a huge success with the children learning so much and having a fantastic time. Next year we will leave on **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> February and we will return to school on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February.**

We have already been successful in a bid for additional funding which will be used to subsidise the visit for all children. The school has also decided to contribute towards the overall cost of the visit, thus we are able to maintain total cost of the visit at £240. The cost without the additional funding would have been £495. This covers all the activities equipment, specialist clothing and transport which school have also contributed to in order to keep the cost down. This represents extremely good value for money when compared to other, similar visits to other organisations across the country. We have secured an initial 24 places at the centre, with an additional 12 places potentially available dependent upon demand.

Throughout the week all the activities, both during the day and in the evening, will be led by fully qualified, experienced instructors from the centre with staff from our school supporting and joining in! All activities have been fully risk assessed. The kind of activities undertaken are gorge walking, raft building, canoeing, mountain climbing, night hikes, high rope courses, abseiling and numerous team building tasks. The Ullswater tab on the home page of the school website will take you to photographs of last year's residential if you want to see examples of the kind of activities that they will do.

The school staff who have accompanied the children on the Outward Bound Trust residentials have always been extremely impressed with the instructors, the centre's organisation, the health and safety, the quality of the food and the accommodation.

Places at Howtown are limited due to its popularity with other school parties, so there are only 24 places available to our school, with an additional 12 places potentially available dependent upon demand. Therefore we will be allocating them on a first come first served basis on receipt of the deposit paid via Parent Pay.

If you wish your child to take advantage of this exciting opportunity then a non-refundable\* **deposit of £40** is required as soon as possible to be paid via Parent Pay, this will secure your child's place and then the reply slip must be returned to the office, **this should all be completed no later than Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April.** Clearly, if we do not reach the numbers we anticipate, for the additional 12 places, then these deposits will be fully refunded.

**The remainder of the payments will then be:**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Payment of £40 by 4<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Payment of £40 by 9<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

**4<sup>th</sup> Payment of £40 by 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021**

**5<sup>th</sup> Payment of £40 by 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2025**

**Last Payment of £40 by 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2021**

**The payment item will be live on Parent Pay from 9.30am on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April.** Therefore you must ensure that your account is activated by this date to allow you to make the deposit payment. If we have identified that your child's account has not yet been activated, we have sent you a separate letter containing a reminder of your Parent Pay login. If you have already activated your account but cannot remember your password, please visit [www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com) and click on the 'Forgotten login details?' link to reset this.

There will be two separate payment items on Parent Pay, one for the initial 24 secured places and one for the possible additional 12 places (should all additional places be taken then we will secure these places on the visit) if you book one of the additional places but there is not sufficient demand you will receive a full refund – please ensure that you select the correct payment item via Parent Pay. **The place can only be secured by paying the deposit via Parent Pay, please refrain from returning the slip below until your deposit has been paid.**

If you have any problems in accessing your account, please contact the school office for further assistance.

We do need to remind you that we will not take children out of school if their behaviour and attitude in school is unacceptable. This is to ensure the safety of all participants. Clearly if this became an issue we would discuss it with you.

We hope very much you will be able to support this residential visit. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me.
